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Key care principles

- Clean spills and organic debris promptly.
- Wash surfaces with mild soap and water.
- Keep gaps, drainage paths and ventilation areas clear.
- Test unfamiliar cleaners on a small offcut first.

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Routine Care for Decking & Cladding

This guide covers routine cleaning and basic care for We Do Bamboo bamboo composite decking and cladding. Regular maintenance helps preserve appearance, drainage and long-term performance. Our products are designed to be low maintenance and do not require sanding, sealing or painting.

1 What you will need



Water



Mild soap



Soft or medium-bristle brush



Bucket



Garden hose / pressure washer



Pressure washing is optional. Use a wide fan tip, keep pressure below 1500 psi, and keep the nozzle at least 300 mm from the surface. Test first in an inconspicuous area.

2 Routine cleaning

Decking



- Sweep away dust, leaves and abrasive dirt.
- Wash with warm water and mild soap.
- Scrub in the direction of the grain and keep board gaps clear.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow the surface to dry.

Cladding



- Rinse off loose dirt, splash marks and bird droppings.
- Wash using mild soapy water with a sponge or long-reach brush.
- Clean in the direction of the grain and between profiles.
- Rinse thoroughly, especially in lower splash zones.

4 What to avoid

- ⊗ Harsh solvents or aggressive cleaners.
- ⊗ Wire brushes, abrasive pads, or metal tools.
- ⊗ Narrow pressure-washer tips or spraying too close to the surface.
- ⊗ Long contact with paint, cement, PVC glue or construction residue.
- ⊗ Standing water, blocked drainage or trapped debris.

3 Preventive care

- Clean spills, grease and organic matter promptly.
- Lift rather than drag furniture or heavy objects.
- Use protective pads under furniture and planters.
- Keep drainage outlets and ventilation paths unobstructed.
- Move mats and accessories from time to time to avoid uneven weathering.
- Inspect trims, fixings and edges periodically.

5 Recommended maintenance schedule

Frequency	Recommended action
As needed	Sweep or rinse surfaces, clean spills, and remove leaves or debris.
Monthly	Wash high-use areas and inspect shaded or wet zones for mould or algae.
Quarterly	Deep clean and check fasteners, trims, drains and ventilation paths.
Annually	Carry out a full visual inspection and address any site-specific issues.



Always test unfamiliar cleaning products on an offcut or hidden area first. This document provides general guidance and should be used together with the relevant product data sheet and installation instructions.
